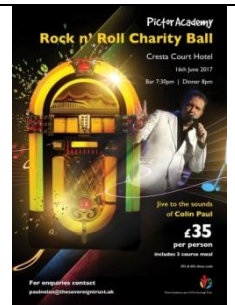
This is a celebration of Leigh Webber and Team Pictor's journey to the Great Run Manchester 10K and is a chance to

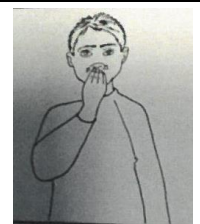
**Toy Library**

Held under the nose, waves from side to side.



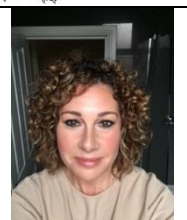
**The Gruffalo**

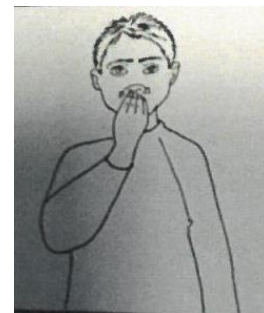
