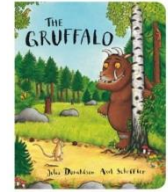


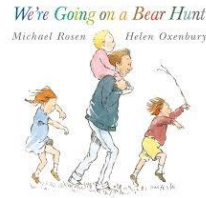
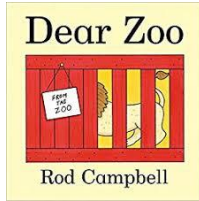
Hello From Class 4
