Context for Learning

ART & DT

Play dough making numbers, numicon, rollers and cutters, playdough for rolling, imprinting and modelling

Cooking: Gruffalo food/ picnic food (with TH)

Cutting & sticking collage linked to stories & plants (using scissors)

ICT

Typing names into computer using keyboard – word, overwriting names – notebook

Clicker 6 typing/ ordering/ labelling pictures

Switchit Jigsaw game

RM easymaths as appropriate

History & Geography

Weekly outings to park, café, garden centre, Gruffalo trail Class books

English

Group Stories: THE Gruffalo, The Gruffalo's child, Jaspers beanstalk

<u>Reading:</u> Share class stories, make class versions of books and individual simplified versions of books individual reading ORT and others at appropriate level

Phonics: Songs, espresso activities Making words linked to stories using magnetic letters.

<u>Writing/ mark making:</u> Daily individualised hand writing activity to practice letter formation initially of names then to include surname - in books, whiteboards, computer

Clicker 6 compose simple phrases/sentences to accompany pictures and photos. Ordering sentences. Labelling pictures using model to copy from or cut + stick.

Speaking and Listening: To greet peers + adults when they come in and when they leave.

To make clear, directed requests to the right adult in snacks- use PECS, names, picture prompts as appropriate. Additional individual targets linked to S<. Lego therapy to direct/follow instructions given by peers.

Maths

Group time: Counting and addition using numicon with daily 'who is here today' faces.

Counting and dance songs.

Individual Work: individualised to meet EAP targets

Ordering/sorting linked to size- big / little. Measuring- height / length/volume- standard non-standard measures

Science

To grow plants from seed-observe, measure and describe growth

Observe growth beans

Begin to know what plants need to grow.

Describe features of plants -root, stem, leaf, flower
