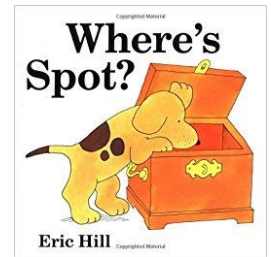
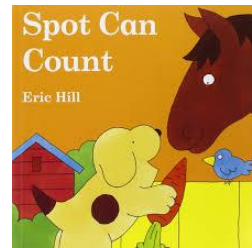


Hello From Class 4

Our topic this half term is on **Spot the dog books**. We will be sharing the books 'Where's Spot?', 'Spot bakes a cake', 'Spot can count' and leading into Christmas with 'Spot's First Christmas'. These are great early books that use simple language and have flaps to open.

We will be encouraging the children to respond to books and join in by:

- pausing for the children to fill in the gap. 'Is he under the stairs....'
- using toys and real activities that relate to the book (e.g. baking a cake)

We will be developing awareness of positional language through playing hiding games (e.g. hiding toys for children to find, Peepo and hide and seek).

Games like these help to build social skills e.g. having fun with people, anticipating what's coming next and taking a turn. Using simple language helps the children tune into the game and predict what is happening next.



We have started to use email to share photographs each term of what we have been learning. This is a way for you to send us photographs or emails about what your child has been doing at home.
